

Primary Water & Waste Supplies Order Information & Conditions

All primary water and waste supplies to each chalet or outdoor exhibit building will be supplied directly by Farnborough International Ltd (FIL). Orders must be requested using this order form:

The deadline for ordering primary water and waste supplies is Monday 15 April 2024

All internal chalet pipework and plumbing must be completed by a supplier/contractor you appoint directly. There is a list of suppliers that can be used for the internal chalet plumbing available on E-Net.

The primary water and waste supply items have been compiled as a package for convenience (Package A). The services available for order and the pricing are set out in the table below:

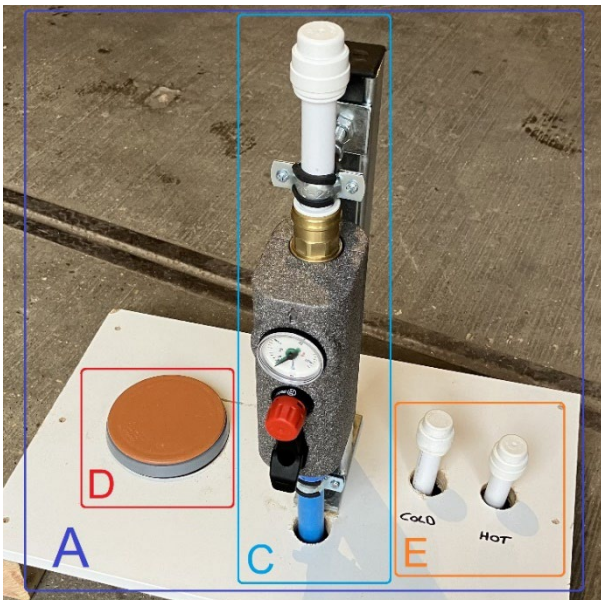


Image A

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Order Information & Conditions

Installation Rules:

- A. The supply pipework entry point is to be within 2m from the front of the chalet unit (road side). The location for outside exhibit structures will be reviewed on application.
- B. The packaged supplies will terminate through the floor in ONE location in the chalet, similar in configuration to that shown in **image A**.
- C. The flow and return feeds for water heaters (where ordered) will terminate in the adjacent chalet façade area to be used for external water heaters. Water heaters are NOT supplied and will need to be supplied by your appointed plumber. Water heaters are NOT permitted under the floor and if located outside must be within the facade area.
- D. All internal chalet plumbing, and pipework must be completed by a competent supplier/contractor of your choice. FIL do not offer further plumbing services directly.
- E. No other pipework other than that installed by FIL is permitted to be routed under the floor of the structures.
- F. All pipework from the point of supply MUST be planned into your design within the inside of the chalet or structure. This is recommended to be routed through/behind the temporary walls that you install.
- G. Additional water feeds and waste outlets can be ordered (items C and D), however these are dependent on the location and may not always be possible.
- H. PDF plans MUST be submitted with the order form, clearly identifying the dimensions of the required position for the incoming pipework supply. Orders will not be accepted without suitable plans.
- I. All internal chalet plumbing must be earth bonded to the exhibitor's electrical distribution system by the exhibitor in accordance with the 18th edition of the IEE Wiring Regulations with current amendments, otherwise known as BS 7671: Regulations for Electrical Installations
- J. Where the Chalet or Outside Exhibit Building is not provided by FIL the exhibitor, or their appointed contractor, must either (A) permit FIL to drill the required holes through the floor for the oncoming supplies or (B) provide holes or access hatches that FIL's appointed installer can use.
- K. Water and Waste supplies are not permitted, or possible, in the exhibition halls.

Conditions:

- 1) By placing an order, you agree to the above pricing, service inclusions/exclusions, Installation rules and have read and agree to these conditions.
- 2) No order is confirmed until an invoice is issued by FIL. FIL will firstly confirm if the installation is possible and if so, will issue an invoice for 100% payment within 14 days.
- 3) Water and waste water services will only be live from the 21st to the 26th July 2024 inclusive. Any supplies required earlier than this will be subject to prior agreement with FIL.
- 4) All the materials installed for the supplies always remain the property of FIL and are on a rental basis. Any missing or damaged materials will be charged to the exhibiting company or their appointed contractor.
- 5) Where the Chalet or Outside Exhibit Building is not provided by FIL the exhibitor or their appointed contractor agrees to fully indemnify FIL (or their appointed installer) for any costs associated for the required holes through the floor and damage thereof.
- 6) Payment must be made in full before the supplies are installed and switched on.
- 7) All prices in this document and shown on the order form exclude VAT which shall be added to invoices at the prevailing rate.
- 8) Orders submitted after the deadline will be subject to a 20% surcharge.
- 9) Orders placed onsite must be paid for in full using a credit card.
- 10) Any on-site changes to orders are subject to approval by FIL and a 50% order value surcharge fee.
- 11) Unless stated otherwise in this document FIL's Exhibition Space Terms and Conditions and Exhibition Regulations will apply to this order.
- 12) FIL reserves the right to deny any on-site changes if the location cannot be accessed or altered without excessive disruption and /or damage to the structure.
- 13) FIL may terminate the order at any point by giving 5 business days' written notice. FIL may also terminate the order with immediate effect by giving written notice if payment is not made for the services.
- 14) FIL have the right to suspend the supply of services ordered if payment is not made for the services.
- 15) If FIL have reasonable grounds to doubt the quality of the water supply, it has the right to cease the supply of the services immediately.
- 16) FIL shall not be liable for any costs, damages or losses arising (whether directly or indirectly) from interruptions, suspensions, failures or changes in the supply and/or quality of the water supply.
- 17) FIL have the right to perform additional examinations and tests of the water quality and to take measures to assess the water quality where necessary. The exhibitor or their contractor shall fully co-operate with FIL in obtaining any water samples.
- 18) The exhibitor warrants and represents that it is aware of the hazards of Legionella and therefore knows that hot water systems in which the water temperature is between 24 degrees Celsius and 60 degrees Celsius may pose a danger to public health. The exhibitor must take all measures that may be reasonably required of it, or that are imposed on it by law, to prevent contamination hazards due to Legionella.
- 19) The exhibitor shall be liable and agrees to fully indemnify FIL against any expense, liability, loss, claim or proceedings in respect of any personal injury, death or damage to property insofar as such injury, death or damage arises out of or in the course of or by reason of any negligence, breach of statutory duty, omission or default of the exhibitor, its servants or agents, or of any person employed or contracted by the exhibitor in connection with the supply of primary water and waste, except to the extent that the same is due to any act or neglect by FIL or any person for whom FIL is responsible.
